



Home Energy Audit Program

Participating Home Energy Auditor Requirements

Businesses interested in delivering Seattle City Light (SCL) Home Energy Audits must meet the pre-training requirements noted below prior to enrollment in the Home Energy Audit Certification training.

Pre-Training Requirements

1. Professional Certification/Accreditation

- Each Auditor must have either accreditation with BPI or have successfully completed equivalent certification, to be approved by SCL.
- Documentation of certification is required with the submission of the Home Energy Auditor Application.

2. Insurance and Bond

- Each auditor must be insured and bonded.
- Proof of insurance and bond is required with the submission of the Home Energy Auditor Application.

3. License

- Each auditor is required to have an active Washington Business License with Washington State Department of Labor and Industries.
- Proof of Washington Business License is required with the submission the Home Energy Auditor Application.

4. Equipment Requirements

The following equipment must be furnished by the contractor, including applicable training for all listed equipment:

- Blower Door
- Flow Plate
- Infrared Camera

5. Data Collection/System Requirements

Data collected as part of SCL's Home Energy Audit Program will be entered into the Earth Advantage portal. Auditors are required to have PC functionality and wireless connectivity beyond Wi-Fi capability to support collection.

6. ARRA/Stimulus Standards

The City of Seattle will be convening a stakeholder group to recommend standards for targeted hiring and contractor quality assurance. Upon adoption, these standards will apply to contractors providing home energy audits. The addition of these new standards may require re-application to the program to ensure these new requirements are being met.
